## Summer Season Presentation

On May 9th 2025, the children of Prep A presented a special assembly on the 'Summer Season' how seasonal changes impact our lives.

The aim of the assembly was to help children observe, understand the effects of the summer season. Through songs, role plays and informative talks, they explored ...

- how earth experiences different seasons like winter, summer, spring, autumn and monsoon season?
- the important role the sun plays during the summer months.
- tips on how to stay cool, healthy and safe during this season.
- the environmental impact of summer, with a special focus on the importance of water conservation.

The presentation began by a role-play showing how the revolution of the Earth around the sun leads to seasonal changes. Through an engaging role play, they demonstrated how the Earth's tilt on its axis affects the distribution of sunlight across different regions.





They then showcased the five distinct seasons monsoon, autumn, winter, spring and summer highlighting their unique characteristics.



They also emphasized the importance for farmers, explaining how the summer sun plays a vital role in helping crops ripen.



The children then shared practical tips on how to take care of oneself during the summer season. They highlighted the importance of staying hydrated, wearing cotton clothes, eating fresh seasonal fruits/vegetables and using protection against harmful UV rays.



They also shared that while the summer may be hot, it is still important to have fun and stay active- by playing games such as football, going for a swim, or, if outdoor isn't possible, enjoying indoor games or reading storybooks.



They further emphasised the need to care for animals, birds and plants during the scorching summer months, noting the importance of providing them with water and shaded cool environment.



The presentation concluded with a valuable piece of advice from 'Nani', who reminded the children water becomes scarce during the summer months and should be used wisely and not wasted. This message was beautifully conveyed through the song "Thoda ,thoda use karo pani kahti hai yeh meri nani..."



To end the 'Summer Season Presentation' on a high note, the children gave a lively and delightful performance of the song "Summer is the hottest of all seasons....."




The students of Prep A delivered a vibrant and impressive first team effort that explored various aspects of the summer season.
