Once the children entered the post office, they saw how the postman and staff worked, the different shelves for letters to different locations which was really fascinating for them.






After that the Postman stamped the postcards for all the children it was time to post them in the letter box. After this the beautiful outdoor visit came to an end and we were ready to leave back for our school.
