

# Summer Theme Presentation

At Santa Maria children get to experience nature in its abundance. They try to bond with nature and appreciate it, especially during the changing seasons.

On May 4th, 2023, the children of Prep B presented a special assembly on the summer season as part of their efforts to observe and understand the seasons better.

The assembly aimed to raise awareness among the children about...

- the changes summer brings in our life,
- how to stay clean and healthy during this season, and
- the impact of this season on the environment.

The children enthusiastically participated in the assembly and successfully conveyed the message to their peers.

The children began the presentation by explaining what causes the seasons to change. They talked about the earth's tilt and how it affects the amount of sunlight that reaches different parts of the planet. They also explained the four seasons, including summer, monsoon, winter, and spring, and how they differ from each other.



To make the presentation more engaging, the children sang a summer song which helped the children to remember the message more easily.



The children then moved on to discuss how to take care of oneself during the summer season. They explained the importance of staying hydrated, wearing cotton and loose-fitting clothes, and using protection against harmful UV rays. They also talked about the importance of staying in the shade during the hottest parts of the day.



The children then shifted their focus to talk about taking care of animals, birds, and plants during the summer season. They explained that just like humans, animals and birds also feel the heat and need to stay hydrated. They also need shade and cool areas to rest. The children suggested leaving bowls of water outside for birds and animals to drink from and providing shade and water for pets.



They also talked about how to take care of plants during the summer season and explained that plants need more water during hot weather and suggested watering them every day.

Prep B children were able to effectively convey the message as the audience promised to take the message to heart and implement the suggestions given by Prep B children in their daily lives.
