Children learnt that as citizens of this country we have to take care of the historical monuments as we take care of our homes. Children saw scribbling on the monument walls and said:

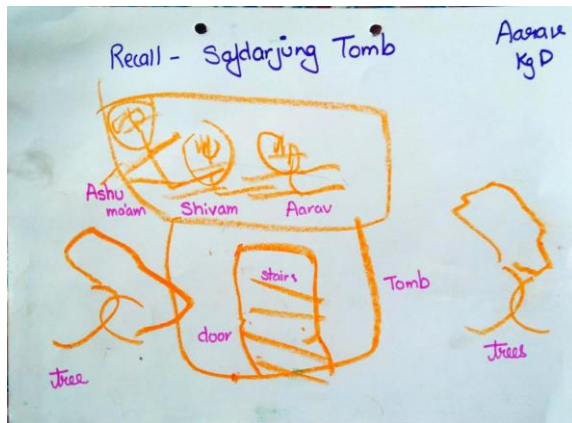
Nishant said, “Yahan to kuch likha hai.”
